Step inside the bus where Rosa Parks took a stand by taking a seat. Play pilot as you explore flight innovations, starting with the Wright brothers' achievements, or make yourself at home inside Buckminster Fuller's circular Dymaxion House. Put yourself in the place of the movers and shakers who blazed the trail to where we stand today. And in doing so, discover your own path.

FORD FACTORY TOUR: Rev up your inner engineer in a five-part experience at a legendary factory — Ford Motor Company's Dearborn Truck Plant. MONDAY NOVEMBER 13, 2023, 1:30-3:30PM RETIREE'S MONTHLY MEMBERSHIP MEETING, MSU SPARTAN STREET MEDICINE PROGRAM, GRAHAM ATKINS, PhD.

Based in the College of Osteopathic Medicine, Spartan Street Medicine is comprised of medical students and physicians united under a commitment to quality healthcare for all. The program provides medical care and health education to people experiencing homelessness in Ingham County in the form of pop-up clinics and outreach trips.

"One of the most important parts of going into the medical field is being able to help the most vulnerable of us," said Osteopathic Medicine student Jordan Lewis. "Being a part of Spartan Street Med has just reaffirmed how important it is to keep advocating for people."

The student-led medical group is now overseen by Dr. Graham Atkin, community advisor, and Dr. Robert Scott and Dr. Michelle Loubert, clinical advisors.

"What we are trying to do is bridge the gap in healthcare for people who are experiencing homelessness in a way that brings them in as partners in their health discovery process and in a way that empowers them to be advocates for their health," Atkin said. "It really is about bringing the clinicians to the patients, going to the people where they are, and helping them as best we can."

### TIME FOR YOUR VACCINE UPDATES.

Check with you doctor to see if you need any of these vaccines.

- Standard Flu Vaccine, if under 65 years of age.
- High Dose Flu Vaccine, if 65 years of age and over.

- Pneumonia
- Tetanus
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Shingles Vaccine
- RSV, if 60 years of age and over with risk factors

These are available at the MSU Health Care Pharmacy. You can schedule an appointment on the <u>Pharmacy website</u> to receive your vaccines. Information about each is also available on the Pharmacy website. MSU retirees, your Humana pharmacy insurance coverage pays for all vaccines with no copay.

### **MSURA ENDOWED STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP FUNDRAISER**

Awarding scholarships to deserving students at the annual MSURA luncheon is one of the most gratifying things we do as an association. Each year we help impressive young Spartans pursue their educational goals through our scholarship program. Since 2016, MSURA has awarded 22 scholarships totaling \$55,000 to students who have a family member who is or was an MSU employee. Initially we were able to award two scholarships. We increased the number to three in 2020 and four in 2022.

Our continuing fundraising efforts and the generosity of our members have enabled us to increase the number of scholarships we award. The fundraising goal we announced in 2021 was \$60,000. When we met that goal we were able to fully endow a third MSURA Scholarship. We have now exceeded our \$60,000 goal by \$10,784. We hope to grow this amount to another \$60,000 which will fully endow a fourth MSURA Scholarship.
