OBSERVING THE 75th ANNIVERSARY OF THE NORMANDY INVASION IN World

War II. On Thursday, June 6, which is the 75th anniversary of the Normandy invasion in World War II, Professor of Geography Emeritus Dr. David Lusch will present a program about the geographical considerations and limitations that General Eisenhower had to work with in the planning of D-Day. Professor Lusch is a student of military history, and has studied this battlefield in person. This event will take place in the Community Room at the Farm Lane Branch of the MSU Federal Credit Union at 1:00 PM on Thursday, June 6, sponsored by the MSU Retirees Association Military History Study Group.
