The "in your mailbox" date: We have no control over the U. S. Postal Service and therefore have made no estimates over when the printed edition will arrive in anyone's mailbox. Of course, the electronic version will always be available considerably earlier than the printed version, usually about two weeks earlier. We have been advised that we must allow 14 days (10 work days) for delivery after our printed and mail prepped copies arrive at the East Lansing post office. Holidays and political campaign mailings tend to slow the mail delivery of our newsletter.

Size of each issue: We give the intended size above. It is possible to expand the size of an already large printed issue (8 or more pages) without greatly increasing the cost of printing, but it is comparatively costly in print charges to go from 4 to 8 pages. Newsletters of 4 or 8 pages normally cost .74 each to mail. If less material is available for an expanded edition by our deadline, we will publish a smaller issue.
